FROM THE BOARD CHAIR

THE MORGANTOWN AREA PART-NERSHIP'S ANNUAL DINNER is an occasion to celebrate what is great about Morgantown and Monongalia County, as well as the people and the businesses that make it exceptional. This is my second time chairing the annual dinner, but who we are now, not only as an organization, but as a community, is much different than my last time at the helm in 2013.

This year — 2024 — marks the start of the Morgantown Area Partnership's second five years in existence. Formed by a group of business and community leaders in 2018 and 2019, we worked to build what was the Morgantown Area Chamber of Commerce into something even more, and in that time, we've combined with the Monongalia County Development Authority (MCDA), the Morgantown Area Economic Partnership, the Campus Neighborhoods Revitalization Corporation — known by many as Sunnyside Up and, just over 15 months ago, with Main Street Morgantown. For more than a century, the Chamber has sought to be the voice of our business community, but in the last five years, we've strived to be a strong and diverse voice of our community as a whole.

That voice is one that encourages progress over stagnation, unity over division, non-partisan action over politically motivated acts. In its short amount of time, the Partnership has gotten our community to pull on the same side of the proverbial rope, to start working together as a unit. As a result, we have seen Morgantown and Monongalia County become a

hotbed in our state for economic development. News has been announced about a handful of our successes, but even more percolates under the surface: some large-scale jobs creators, some qualityof-life projects that can act as a beacon, drawing people to and keeping people in our boarders, and more. This is thanks to the core of our existing community working each day to make the place we a call home a better place to live, work, shop and play.

We've accomplished this by uniting the organizations I mentioned above to bring them together, creating economies of scale and putting a top-notch professional staff behind them. Our president and CEO Russ Rogerson is supported by his vice presidents Erik Carlson and Amy Loomis, Business Manager Tanya Skeens,

Membership & Public Affairs Manager Jacob Coots. Membership Salesman Charlie Sims, Graduate Assistant Matt Porter and Marketing and Communications Coordinator Brooke Bolyard. That team welcomed 101 new members to the Partnership in 2023, cut 21 ribbons on new or celebrating businesses. That brought our total to 524 total members. including 19 investor partners that help drive the mission of the Partnership and provide important financial support to achieve the stated goals the initial board of the Partnership and its associated organizations put into place in 2019 and reaffirmed with all ratifying a second term starting in 2024.

EARL L. CORE AWARD Rita Tanner was committed to community

It was a blustery Saturday in late December more than 20 years ago when Rita Tanner and the other board members of the former Centra Bank gathered at Glenmark Centre for the groundbreaking.

The local chain was opening another branch office, and like the others, this one was also going to be staffed by bankers and staffers who either grew up in Morgantown or formed strong, lasting ties across the city and region — even if they weren't technically "from" here.

Homegrown investment, as it were.

"They all live here," Rita Tanner said then. "That's important for a community

bank like this."

Those words, "important" and "community," were synonymous with the businesswoman and booster who died in February and is posthumously receiving the Morgantown Area Partnership's highest award for service this evening.

That's the Earl L. Core Award for community outreach — with "outreach," being another word that best suits the recipient, her son Seth Tanner said.

His mother had a full portfolio of community service, he said.

He and his four siblings, Seth said, knew about some of her work in her adopted hometown.

Still, there were causes to which their mom was aligned that he didn't know — because she never talked about it, Seth said.

"She just went out and did it. And she encouraged us to do the same. She would always say, 'Whatever you're doing, you can do more.' "

Of country roads and commitment

It was her heart that brought her to the hills of north-central West Virginia.

Rita was born in Chicago and grew up in the Windy City.

She stayed local and was on her way to graduating in three years from Northwestern when an encounter on a spring break in Miami Beach changed everything.

That's where she met the man she would marry, Stephen Tanner, of Morgantown.

After the wedding, and after she formally traded in the flat expanses of the Midwest for the ancient, compact mountains of Appalachia, she dug in like she always did.

CHAIRMAN'S AWARD Neal, Rhodes, Gustafson deserving honorees

This year, Morgantown Area Partnership (MAP) will present three recipients with the Chairman's Award during the organization's Annual Dinner from 5-8:30 p.m. today at the Morgantown Event Center at Morgantown Marriott at Waterfront Place.

Unlike other awards. explains board member Sarah Woodrum, who is also WVU School of Public Health senior associate dean and assistant professor, the Chairman's Award is only given when "we really feel like somebody deserves recognition."

It's meant for those who've worked hard to serve their community in ways that do not fit neatly into the other

award categories. And Woodrum can't think of three more deserving honorees than the late Dr. William Neal, Dr. Larry Rhodes and Dr. Robert "Gus" Gustafson.

"When you work backwards, so much had to be done over 40 years, before 2022, when the state-of-the-art children's hospital opened its doors in Morgantown," she said, referring to WVU Medicine Children's, a standalone nine-story facility that is home to West Virginia's largest group of pediatric primary care physicians and specialists. "These three really are pioneers."

In a rural area like their home state, the West Virginia natives understood the importance of bringing health care to residents — whether that was establishing a system of outreach heart clinics to accommodate the surgical capability of Gustafson, a pediatric heart surgeon, or Neal and Rhodes traveling to all 55 counties providing outreach pediatric cardiology care.

Through community engagement, time spent connecting with local health care providers and by offering an array of educational opportunities, the trio also built relationships throughout the state that proved crucial in terms of funding and support for the new children's hospital.

Neal, a Huntington native who graduated from the WVU School of Medicine in 1966, returned in 1974 to become a faculty member, after completing military service and residency and fellowship training.

"When he came, he said he couldn't take this job unless there was a NICU (neonatal intensive care unit) developed," said Dr. Martha Mullett, a retired WVU pediatrics professor and clinician. So, she said, her late husband started one.

"It was on-the-job training," said Mullett, who became the NICU director in 1978, a position she held until 1998. "You just did it. Somebody began and taught the others. ... We would accept patients with all of these problems and go and get them."

Mullett recalls traveling with Neal to pick up their

The Shack Neighborhood House has been in operation since 1928, serving the Morgantown community for nearly a century.

This year, the organization was selected as the Non-Profit of the Year by the Morgantown Area Partnership.

Shack Neighborhood House's mission is to provide an inclusive, safe and fun environment for learning and recreation. This is achieved largely through its before and after school care program, as well as its extensive summer camp program.

"We were surprised about the award. We weren't expecting it," said the Shack's executive director, Jessica Varner. "We've just been working on our before and after school program and trying to get ready for summer camp. We're very grateful for it and the publicity that comes with it, so everyone can know that we're here for the community."

And The Shack serves the community in a variety of ways.

The before/after school program is at three locations in Monongalia County, serving about 240 kids.

The summer camp will run from June 10 to Aug. 16 and include kids from ages 5-12. For kids who are 13 and older, they can become junior volunteers working in the community.

VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS OF THE YEAR Tanner's Alley honored for decades of service

Tanner's Alley has been the leather goods and repair shop for Morgantown for nearly five decades.

Charlie McEwuen said he started his leather business originally as a hobby during his time in the military.

After the war, McEwuen had a decision to make: go back to college to finish his degree or pursue his handiwork with leather full time.

A leather business at age 22 sounded more "glamorous" to McEwuen, and he took the leap of faith.

Tanner's Alley was established and was first nestled along Walnut Street — "a narrow place ... an alley" — giving his business its name. Tanner's second location was on Spruce Street.

Fast-forward 48 years later and Tanner's Alley is still a major part of downtown Morgantown's rich history and the shops on High Street. And McEwuen's business will be recognized this year as the Veteran-Owned Business of the Year at the Morgantown Area Partnership's Annual Dinner tonight.

McEwuen said that throughout his time as a small-business owner, the most important thing about keeping a business alive is being able to adapt to the environment around you.

"Being in the military did help me learn to adjust to a rapidly changing situation quickly," McEwuen said.

NEW BUSINESS OF THE YEAR Hope Gas strengthens century-old WV roots

Hope Gas has served the state since the early 1900s. In September 2023, West Virginia-based Hope Utilities acquired the legacy from Dominion Energy and quickly launched the rebirth of Hope Gas.

The process began with the help of the Morgantown Area Partnership, said Hope Gas president and CEO Morgan O'Brien.

"One of the first people at the table when we talked about coming to West Virginia was the Morgantown Area Partnership," said O'Brien. "They offered us assistance connecting with people looking for jobs."

Now, the Partnership will

award Hope Gas with New Business of the Year.

It may appear strange for a 125-year-old company to receive an award for new businesses, joked O'Brien, but Hope Gas has been busy achieving a metamorphosis worthy of such a title. The company's goals are simple employing, serving and investing in the Mountain State.

"Our roots are deep and old in West Virginia, and we're working hard at making those roots stronger," said O'Brien.

Eighteen months ago, Hope Gas aimed to hire 100 new employees in its first year of operations. Today, that number is around 240 and growing.

first out-of-town patient in Buckhannon.

"The first transport was in 77. That was in the old hospital," she said, referring to University Hospital, which shut down in 1988.

At first, Mullett said, they were given a room in isolation, where they could fit beds babies. for three That expanded to five beds, then eight, then eight more.

Eventually — under the leadership of Gordon Gee during his first term as president at WVU and with the support of then-Gov. John Rockefeller IV and the state Legislature, as well as a hefty \$8 million contribution from Hazel Ruby McQuain — a hospital under a new nonprofit corporate structure controlled by the university opened in 1988, along with WVU Children's Hospital.

The children's hospital took up the sixth floor of Ruby Memorial Hospital (now J.W. Ruby Memorial Hospital). Neal, who was then-chair of the WVU Department of Pediatrics and became the hospital's first medical director, was instrumental in pushing for its hospital-within-a-hospital design. This meant that general pediatrics, obstetrics and the NICU were not spread out on different floors, as originally intended.

"He was really good at organization and leadership," Mullett said. "That was just him. He wanted to do something for the state and felt he could offer something to the state."

"Everything I do, a tremendous amount of it, can be traced back to him," Rhodes said of Neal. "He was my teacher, my mentor, my chairman and my friend."

And, he added, Neal led by example. He sought ways beyond his usual duties as an administrator, faculty member and doctor to help health outcomes for children across

the state.

For instance, he founded the Coronary Artery Risk Detection in Appalachian Communities (CARDIAC) Project in 1998, which lasted close to 20 years. The schoolbased risk factor surveilintervention lance. and research initiative was designed as a means of reversing the state's disparity in cardiovascular disease, diabetes and other chronic illnesses.

Dr. Lee Pyles, a WVU professor and pediatric cardiologist who trained under Neal and took over the project, agrees with Rhodes' sentiments.

"Larry and I have said to people that we're pediatric cardiologists because of the impact of Dr. Neal. ... The big thing is that Bill was such a people person," Pyles said. "He should have been governor. He had this way of connecting. All of the families loved him because he was kind and straightforward and honest. People very quickly knew they could entrust their children to him."

It's a legacy that Rhodes and Gustafson have carried on in their own rights.

Rhodes, who has served as

a professor of pediatrics in the WVU School of Medicine since 2005 and is the founding director of the university's Institute for Community and Rural Health, thrives on truly getting to know the fellow West Virginians he serves.

"This is where I belong," he said, sharing that one of his favorite parts of his job is driving his truck to clinics or camps and stopping in momand-pop diners and cafes, overhearing customers make a case for round vs. square hay bales or arguing why you shouldn't pay extra for a brand-name tractor. "I live for it."

Raised in Kanawha County and graduating school with Kathy Mattea, Rhodes said the southern part of the state holds a special place in his heart, which is why he helped establish a summer camp there, Tomorrow is Mine, along with brothers Dr. John Brick and Dr. Jim Brick.

The free, weeklong residential camp for children ages 10-12 from Boone, Fayette, Lincoln, Logan, Mingo, McDowell, Raleigh, Summers and Wyoming counties was created for kids who may not otherwise be able to attend a

summer camp. It is held on the WVU Beckley Campus.

"The reason I do that camp. I believe that everything that puts us on the top of every bad list or the bottom of every good one can be traced back to a sense of fatalism," he said. "I truly want these kids to know that they have a tomorrow."

Rhodes has personally recruited well-known West Virginians, like sculptor and artist Jamie Lester, an Oceana native, to share their skills and experiences.

"What it is, is showing the kids a parade of winners from where they're from," he said. "My definition of a winner is someone who can take care of themselves and their families, and raise up their communities."

Rhodes said this year will be the first he steps back from another camp he's been involved with for 26 years — Camp Mountain Heart.

He, Gustafson and Neal were all original sponsors of the free weeklong camp for children and teens, ages 8-17, with congenital and acquired heart disease. Under close medical supervision, the kids

get a chance to participate in a plethora of activities at Cedar Lakes Conference Center in Ripley.

Rhodes said after more than two decades, he knows the camp is in capable hands, and he will now have more time to focus on Tomorrow is Mine, which was established in 2017.

Trusting others to carry on what you've helped build is an idea that Dr. Gustafson had to come to terms with when he decided to retire.

The Keyser native spent most of his career as the only pediatric heart surgeon in the state. In 2020, WVU Medicine Children's announced that Dr. Sertac Cicek would take over as the chief of pediatric and cardiothoracic surgery from Gustafson, who had held the position since 1984.

"He did it all for close to 40 years," Rhodes said. "He's the glue that helped hold this thing together. I was away for a decade, and he stayed. He had every opportunity to leave. He was recruited for some big-time places around the country. We worked a ton together."

Rhodes remembers the earlier days in their careers, when they bonded while monitoring babies after heart surgery.

"Sometimes two of us were there all night, the same night," he said. "Gus and I are still good friends and became good friends from bed-sitting."

Gustafson too recalls those early days, when he, Neal and Rhodes were on a mission.

"We wanted to improve the pediatric care in West Virginia and worked hard for many, many years to do that. ... Bill's

initial effort was to set up outpatient clinics, seven or eight of them, so parents didn't have to drive so far. And at the same time, [we] were working to try to get all the West Virginia patients that needed surgery to come to Morgantown, rather than to have them go to Cincinnati, or Pittsburgh, or Duke or Columbus."

For his part, Gustafson worked to build the pediatric heart surgery program that would be part of the foundation for the university's children's hospital. During his time in practice, he served more than 15,000 patients and averaged about 175 surgeries a year.

"I was the sole player until the last couple of years," Gustafson said. "I had a second person join me. Then I retired, and they replaced me. So, now I imagine it's a little easier to get some time off."

In 2022, after the opening of

the new children's hospital, the professor emeritus of Cardiovascular and Thoracic at the WVU School of Medicine was celebrated with an operating room named in his honor.

Neal's name can also be found on campus, as the William A. Neal Museum of the Health Sciences opened in 2022. Rhodes and his wife. Terry, contributed \$50,000 to support the museum named for their friend, who died Jan. 1. 2021. at 80.

"When Dr. Neal passed away, it made me stop and think, 'What is my legacy? What are all of our legacies?" Woodrum said. "These three doctors didn't need to be the ones on stage. They spent years behind the scenes. ... So many people now want outcomes quickly. They understood you have to do it one child at a time."
